

In an email dated January 7, 2019, the Chief Firearms Office has asked that we share the following information on Authorization to Transport with our shooting club members.

Authorization to Transport ... reminder to all your club/range membership regarding Bill C42 which passed September 2015.

Attached is a copy of the licence conditions that were automatically attached to the firearms licence of any of your members who had a valid authorization to transport issued to transport to your shooting club/range at that time the bill was passed. If your members are unsure if they have the additional conditions attached to their firearms licence please inform them to contact the CFO directly @ 1-800-731-4000 - 1 - 1 Extension #7503.

Please note: if your membership wishes to transport their restricted firearms for any other purpose which is not listed on the licence conditions (below), they are required to contact our office @ 1-800-731-4000 - 1 - 1 Extension #7503 to have an authorization to transport issued for that specific purpose. In addition: Any client who purchased a new restricted firearm after September 2015 will automatically have the attached conditions added to their firearms licence.

**These licence conditions authorize the transport of restricted and/or prohibited firearms registered to the licence holder within their province of residence by a route that, in all circumstances, is reasonably direct for the specific indicated purposes.**

- 1) Transportation of restricted firearms and/or prohibited handguns [12(6.1) of the Firearms Act] possessed for the purpose of target practice to and from all shooting clubs and ranges approved under section 29 of the Firearms Act.
- 2) Transportation of restricted firearms and/or prohibited firearms to and from any place a peace officer, firearms officer or Chief Firearms Officer (CFO) is located for verification, registration or disposal in accordance with the Firearms Act or Part III of the Criminal Code.
- 3) Transportation of restricted firearms and/or prohibited firearms to and from a business that holds a licence authorizing it to repair or appraise prohibited or restricted firearms.
- 4) Transportation of restricted firearms and/or prohibited firearms to and from a gun show.
- 5) Transportation of restricted firearms and/or prohibited firearms to a port of exit, in order to take them outside Canada and from a port of entry.
- 6) Transportation of newly acquired restricted firearms and/or prohibited firearms from the place of acquisition to the licence holder's dwelling house or other place authorized by the CFO.
