Membership Application Process

Applications are accepted from October 1 to December 31 each year

It starts with your application.

- Find it on the HCMC web page
- Fill it out completely and print off
- Include required documentation
- Include a cheque for the appropriate amount
- Sign the form
- Mail to HCMC Box 56 Kinmount Ontario K0M 2A0 between October 1 and December 31

Next steps

- Expect to hear from an HCMC Officer late January or early February
- Sign up for an interview
- Attend you interview
- Wait to hear if you are accepted on a Probationary Basis



Once a Probationary Member

- Sign up for a New Member Safety Training Course
- Attend a New Member Safety Training Course and get your probationary log book and Club ID badge
- Attend at least 2 New Member Shoots as per the schedule
- You must use the same firearm for all your probationary shoots
- You must wear eye protection and electronic ear protection during all shoots
- Sign up for a Pistol and Holster Clinic weekend if you wish to increase your skills and/or wear a holster at the club
- Attend a total of at least 6 shoots as a probationary member and obtain a captain's signature each time. Depending on your skill level you may be asked to attend more supervised shoots
- If you are wanting a non-restricted membership <u>all</u> probationary shoots must be using a non-restricted firearm
- If you are wanting a restricted firearm membership <u>all</u> probationary shoots must be using a restricted firearm
- Submit your completed probationary log to a Board Member so it can be taken to the next Board meeting
- If approved, the Chief Range Safety Officer, will contact you for a tour of the facility and you will receive your full membership card



Once you have full membership status and you want independent access to the Club

- Request permission from the Board of Officers to attend a Range Safety Officer (RSO) course
- Check the Range Schedule for dates for RSO courses
- E-mail the appropriate person to sign up for a specific course
- Attend the course prepared to participate in both a classroom session and live fire
- If you pass the RSO course you will receive a membership card with a RSO designation on it after a final tour
- During the final tour you will also receive the gate and Clubhouse combinations.
