

HCMC FAQs

How do I become a member?

- Complete the HCMC Member Application Form which you can find on the HCMC website usually in August or September for the following year
- Submit the completed application between October 1 and December 31
- Have a PAL or RPAL and a CSSA membership and submit photocopies of both sides of each card. You can apply if you are waiting to receive your card(s) but won't receive your probationary card until you do.
- Submit a cheque for the appropriate amount. Your cheque won't be cashed until you are accepted as a probationary member.
- Submit references from 2 HCMC members or be interviewed by one or more board members

What can I do as a probationary member?

- Take HCMC courses
- Attend scheduled events at the range
- Accompany a full member (RSO qualified) to the range

How do I become a full member?

- Take part in a minimum of 6 shoots and be signed off as safe by the shoot captain. If you want a restricted membership they must be restricted shoots
- After 6 sign-offs submit your probationary shoot sign-offs to the board to see if you are accepted for full membership or will need to attend more shoots or coaching

How do I gain full access to HCMC?

- Be approved for full membership by the board
- Take the HCMC club level RSO course
